### Student Resident's Dress Code

All clothing must be modest -- ANYTHING too short, tight, or revealing will not be allowed. Any clothing deemed inappropriate by staff will be held until departure.

1. No spaghetti straps, no tank tops (except for undershirts) no backless dresses or blouses.
2. No low cut tops, no crop tops, no shirts that reveal the belly or waist area.
3. No low-cut pants or jeans; No hip huggers; No spandex-style or clinging pants.
4. No pants, jeans or other clothing with rips, tears or in general bad condition allowed.
5. Shorts are to be no more than 2-3 inches above kneecap.
6. Bras and panties must be worn with all clothing except sleepwear.
7. Sleepwear must be modest, no short shorts; robe must be worn over clothing when not sleeping.
8. No clothing with obscene language, secular messages, pictures of, or anything representing tobacco, drugs, secular music, the occult or racism, etc.

Since storage space is limited, the amount of clothing allowed at Priscilla's Place is also limited. FOLLOWING IS A LIST OF MINIMUM AND MAXIMUM ALLOWED.

**Restricted items:**

Hair coloring products  
Sunless tanning products  
Herbs/Herbal remedies  
Laxatives, douches  
Over-the-counter meds that cause sleepiness. (Non-drowsy kind will be permitted if needed.)  
Gum  
Smoke cessation aids  
Tobacco, drugs, alcohol  
Lighters, matches, rolling papers, etc.  
Poker cards, dice, gambling devices  
Hand held games  
Cell phones  
Personal pillows, blankets, heating pads  
Gaudy jewelry, nose rings/ studs  
Eyebrow, tongue, lip, bellybutton or other body pierced rings/studs allowed  
NOTHING with drug, alcohol, tobacco, occult, racism symbols  
Weapons, guns, knives, box cutters, scissors  
Straight razors, brass knuckles  
Car, bicycle, vehicle of any kind  
CD's, Tapes, VHS, DVD's  
Players, TV's, Radios, ipods, etc.  
Laptop computers, musical instruments  
Secular Books, magazines
